Project Update - June 2021





Have your say on

the future of Ryde Hospital

The NSW Government is investing \$479 million in the redevelopment of Ryde Hospital to meet the future health needs of the growing community.

An options assessment is underway as part of the early planning process to determine the most appropriate site for the redevelopment.

Feedback is sought by 30 June 2021 and will help inform the investigations and identification of the preferred site.

What is happening on the project?

The project is in the early planning phase with an options assessment underway to identify the most suitable location for the redevelopment.

The two options being considered are redeveloping the hospital on the existing campus, or relocating the hospital to the Macquarie University North Ryde campus.

The assessment is being informed by clinical requirements, independent technical assessments and feedback from the community, health service staff and consumers.

The independent technical assessments will consider:

- Access
- Traffic
- Environmental impacts
- Social amenity
- Economic analysis.

What is the planning based on?

The Clinical Services Plan (CSP) for Ryde Hospital forms the foundation of the planning for the redevelopment.

Northern Sydney Local Health District developed the CSP in consultation with health service staff, consumer representatives, clinical networks and the Northern Sydney Local Health District Executive and Clinical Council, as well as affiliated organisations, service delivery partners, universities and local government.

The CSP considers how the health care needs of the community can be serviced into the future, taking into account forecasts of the population's changing needs, as well as other clinical networks and relationships with nearby hospitals and health facilities.
