The NSW Government is investing \$479 million in the redevelopment of Ryde Hospital to meet the future health needs of the growing community.

The redevelopment will deliver a new and expanded emergency department and intensive care unit, new theatres, new purpose-built ambulatory care centre, new paediatric short stay unit, more adult overnight inpatient beds and expanded medical imaging.

Health Infrastructure's projects provide significant opportunities to contribute to the sustainability of NSW's healthcare system and Ryde Hospital is one of many NSW healthcare facilities adopting sustainable practices into its design and operations.







Striving for Net Zero 2025

The Northern Sydney Local Health District (NSLHD) has a goal of reaching net zero carbon emissions by 2035 for all hospitals in the area, including Ryde. Ryde Hospital will contribute towards the net zero goal through environmental, social and economic sustainability initiatives.
