


Fact Sheet Ryde Hospital Redevelopment

Parking and access changes at Ryde Hospital from 3 March 2025



As we prepare for the construction of the new Acute Services Building access, and parking changes will be implemented from Monday 3 March 2025 to clear the construction footprint.

How do I access the hospital campus?

Entry and exit will be via Denistone Road.

Vehicles will now enter and exit via Denistone Road. Vehicle entry is via the undercroft staff parking area and exit via the road next to NSW Ambulance – previously the entry road.

This includes parents dropping off children at the childcare centre.

The 2M height restriction for vehicles entering the hospital site will be reinstated.

The temporary internal road, exiting onto Ryedale Road, will be closed.

Clear signage will be installed to guide vehicle movements and traffic controllers will be in place for a short period of time to help navigate the changes.

What are the changes to parking?

Patient and visitor parking will remain unchanged.

Patient and visitor parking is available in the two car parks behind the main hospital building. These are accessed via the Denistone Road entrance and exit.

Afternoon staff parking area (P6) will be relocated to the undercroft parking.

The undercroft parking is reserved for afternoon hospital staff for safety at the end of their shift. The area will continue to be sectioned off until 11am each day for afternoon staff.

The 2M height restriction for vehicles entering the hospital site will be reinstated.

Frequently Asked Questions

How is traffic being managed safely?

Safety is our number one priority. Clear signage will be installed to guide vehicle movements and traffic controllers will be in place for a short period of time as these changes take effect.

Please take care when walking, driving and parking on campus and always follow the direction of traffic controllers.

Will the Emergency Department and front entrance to the hospital remain open through the works?

Yes. Access to the Emergency Department and front entrance to the hospital from Denistone Road will remain open at all times.

Can I still drop-off or park at the front entrance/ Emergency Department?

Yes, patients and visitors may still use the Denistone Road drop-off at the front entrance to the hospital and the Emergency Department.

There are also limited parking spaces at the drop-off area for those displaying disability parking permits.

Where can visitors park?

Two hour patient and visitor parking is available in the two car parks behind the main hospital building – labelled 'P' on the map.

Where can I park with a disability parking permit?

Disability parking remains accessible in multiple locations on the Ryde Hospital campus including:

- at the front entry and Emergency Department (accessed from Denistone Road).
- allocated disabled parking in the patient and visitors parking (accessed from Denistone Road).
- at the Graythwaite Rehabilitation Centre (accessed from Fourth Avenue).

What parking options will be available when the redevelopment is complete?

Once construction is complete the redevelopment will almost double the number of parking spaces available on campus.

Additional car parking will include:

- parking accessible off Denistone Road which will include two levels of basement parking, and
- various on-grade car parks off Ryedale Road and Denistone Road.

Will there be further traffic changes?

Staff and community will be informed in advance of any access and parking changes that may be required as the construction of the Ryde Hospital Redevelopment progresses.
